MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE FOR ANNUAL FUEL TRACKER FILING

Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 C.F.R. § 385.212 (2009), and for good cause shown, Enogex LLC ("Enogex" or "Company") respectfully moves for Commission authorization to extend the deadline for its annual fuel tracker filing from Monday, November 16, 2009 to no later than Monday, November 23, 2009. In support of this Motion, Enogex states as follows:

Background

Pursuant to the fuel tracker as set forth in Exhibit A of Enogex's Statement of Operating Conditions Applicable to Transportation Services ("SOC"), Enogex establishes and charges a set fuel percentage for gas shipped on the East Zone of its system and a separate set fuel percentage for gas shipped on the West Zone. The percentages are adjusted annually and are in effect from January 1 through December 31 (the "Fuel Year"). Pursuant to the SOC, Enogex is required to file the fuel percentages and supporting workpapers with the Commission on or before November 15 of the year preceding the Fuel Year (or the next business day if, as this year, November 15 falls on a weekend) and to implement the percentages on January 1 of the subject Fuel Year.

Motion to Extend Filing Deadline

Enogex respectfully requests an additional seven (7) days to make its annual fuel filing from Monday, November 16, 2009 to Monday November 23, 2009. Enogex requests this additional time to allow it to review its data and calculations for the filing including actual fuel

data that just recently became available for October 2009. Enogex respectfully advises the Commission that the additional time sought by this Motion will permit Enogex to be as accurate as possible in the zonal fuel percentages requested for Fuel Year 2010.

Enogex also respectfully notes that the additional few days will not impose an undue burden on Enogex shippers. The fuel percentages do not go into effect until January 1, 2010, subject to refund, meaning the shippers will not be relying on such percentages until the last week of December 2009 when shippers nominate for January 2010. Enogex believes that sufficient time exists between November 23, 2009 and the last week of December for the shippers and Commission Staff to review the Fuel Year 2010 filing. Moreover, because the percentages are not only subject to refund, as of January 1, 2010, but also ultimately subject to a value-based true-up in the following Fuel Year, shippers are doubly protected and will be asked to provide no more and no less than the fuel to be used by the Enogex system in Fuel Year 2010.

Conclusion

For the foregoing reasons and for good cause shown, Enogex respectfully requests that the Commission extend the deadline for Enogex's 2009 Fuel Year filing from November 16, 2009 to no later than November 23, 2009.


