MOTION TO EXTEND DEADLINE FOR ANNUAL FUEL TRACKER FILING

Pursuant to Rule 212 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, 18 CFR § 385.212 (2008), and for good cause shown, Enogex LLC ("Enogex" or "Company") respectfully seeks permission to extend the deadline for its annual fuel percentages filing for up to four days, that is, to no later than Friday, November 21, 2008. In support of its Motion, Enogex states as follows:

Background

Pursuant to Exhibit A of Enogex's Statement of Operating Conditions ("SOC"), Enogex charges a fixed fuel percentage for gas shipped on the East Zone of its system and a separate fixed fuel percentage for gas shipped on the West Zone. The percentages are adjusted annually and are in effect from January 1 through December 31 (the "Fuel Year"). Enogex is required to file the fuel percentages and supporting workpapers with the Commission on or before November 15 of the year preceding the Fuel Year (or the next business day if, as this year, November 15 falls on a weekend) and implement the percentages on January 1 of the subject Fuel Year.

Motion to Extend Filing Deadline

As the draft fuel filing for Fuel Year 2009 was recently circulated more broadly within the Company for final review, questions arose regarding certain data in the filing. It was decided to examine these data more closely and certain persons were not immediately available to provide input. Enogex personnel are now in the process of completing the data review and

expect to make the Fuel Year 2009 filing in the next few days but no later than Friday, November 21, 2008. The additional time will permit Enogex to be as accurate as possible in the estimated zonal fuel percentages filed for Fuel Year 2009.


Enogex respectfully suggests that the additional few days will not impose an undue burden on Enogex shippers. The fuel percentages do not go into effect until January 1, 2009, subject to refund, meaning the shippers will not be relying on such percentages until the last week of December 2008 when shippers nominate for January 2009. Enogex believes that sufficient time exists between November 21, 2008 and the last week of December for the shippers and Commission Staff to review the Fuel Year 2009 filing. Moreover, because the percentages are not only subject to refund, as of January 1, 2009, but also ultimately subject to a value-based true-up in the following Fuel Year, shippers are doubly protected and will be asked to provide no more and no less than the fuel used by the Enogex system.

Conclusion

For the foregoing reasons and for good cause shown, Enogex respectfully requests that the Commission extend the deadline for Enogex's 2009 Fuel Year filing from November 17, 2008 to no later than November 21, 2008.
