Dear Ms. Thompson:

On November 23, 2009, Enogex Inc. (Enogex) submitted for filing proposed fuel factors of 0.92% for the East Zone of the Enogex System and 1.12% for the West Zone of the Enogex System, pursuant to Exhibit A to the Statement of Operating Conditions and the settlement approved in Enogex Inc., Docket Nos. PR02-10-005, *et al.*¹ Enogex states that the proposed fuel factors are to be effective January 1, 2010 through December 31, 2010. The proposed fuel factors are accepted effective January 1, 2010, as requested.

Public notice of the filing was issued on December 9, 2009. Interventions and protests were due on or before December 18, 2009. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2009)), all timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No adverse comments or protests were filed.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of any service, rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your filing; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such action is without prejudice to any findings or orders which

have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your company.
