Reference: Fuel Factors Filing

Dear Ms. Thompson:

On July 1, 2010, Enogex LLC (Enogex) submitted for filing proposed fuel factors of 0.69% for the East Zone of the Enogex System and 0.59% for the West Zone of the Enogex System, pursuant to a proposed revision to Exhibit A to the Statement of Operating Conditions¹ (SOC) revising the timing of the annual fuel percentages filing and changing the months that comprise the Fuel Year. Enogex requested that the proposed fuel factors be effective August 1, 2010 through March 31, 2011. The proposed fuel factors and the revision to Exhibit A to the SOC are accepted effective August 1, 2010, as requested.

Public notice of the filing was issued on July 13, 2010. Interventions and protests were due on or before July 26, 2010. Pursuant to Rule 214 (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2010)), all timely filed motions to intervene and any motion to intervene out-of-time filed before the issuance date of this order are granted. Granting late intervention at this stage of the proceeding will not disrupt the proceeding or place additional burdens on existing parties. No adverse comments or protests were filed.

This acceptance for filing shall not be construed as constituting approval of

the referenced filing or of any rate, charge, classification, or any rule, regulation, or practice affecting such rate or service contained in your SOC; nor shall such acceptance be deemed as recognition of any claimed contractual right or obligation associated therewith; and such acceptance is without prejudice to any findings or orders which have been or may hereafter be made by the Commission in any proceeding now pending or hereafter instituted by or against your company.

This order constitutes final agency action. Requests for rehearing by the Commission may be filed within 30 days of the date of issuance of this order, pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 385.713 (2010).
