**Re: Enogex LLC, Docket No. PR09-16-000:
Errata Filing: Revised Rate Summary Sheet for Inclusion
in Statement of Operating Conditions**

Dear Ms. Bose:

Enogex LLC (“Enogex”) submits for filing, in this Docket No. PR09-16-000, a revised Exhibit B for inclusion in Enogex’s revised Statement of Operating Conditions Applicable to Transportation Services (“SOC”). Exhibit B is a rate summary sheet.

Background

Enogex filed the revised SOC on February 27, 2009, to include provisions describing the terms and conditions associated with a new firm transportation service that was initiated on the Enogex Transmission System on April 1, 2009, pursuant to Section 311(a)(2) of the Natural Gas Policy Act of 1978.¹ Enogex noted in the transmittal letter accompanying the revised SOC filing that it was not including the rate summary sheet required by Order No. 714.² Order No. 714 requires an intrastate pipeline offering Section 311 services to include a rate summary with its SOC the first time that an intrastate pipeline files to change its Section 311 rates after the issuance of Order No. 714. Enogex sought a temporary waiver of such requirement for good cause shown and to the extent necessary.

As good cause, Enogex explained that it intended to make a rate filing in the near future, on or before March 31, 2009, and that such rate filing would be its first since the issuance of Order No. 714. However, Enogex further explained that, as of February 27, 2009, it had not yet completed the filing and, accordingly, did not yet have available the rates to be shown on the

rate summary sheet. Enogex stated that it would file the required rate summary sheet once the rate filing was completed and the proposed rates were known.

Enogex made the rate filing on March 27, 2009, and filed Exhibit B, the rate summary sheet, shortly thereafter on April 1, 2009. In the transmittal letter accompanying the Exhibit B filing, Enogex explained that the submission of the rate summary sheet was strictly ministerial and for the sole purpose of complying with the requirement of Order No. 714 with respect to the inclusion of a rate summary sheet in the SOC.

Reason for Errata Filing

It has now come to Enogex's attention that the Exhibit B, rate summary sheet, submitted on April 1, 2009 has two typographical errors and does not conform exactly, as it should, to the rate summary sheet in the rate filing. A revised Exhibit B, rate summary sheet, and a redlined copy highlighting the two typographical errors is submitted for filing. There are no other changes. Enogex asks that this corrected Exhibit B be placed in the SOC immediately behind Exhibit A.




