**Re: Enogex LLC, Docket No. PR09-22-000:
Additional Firm Section 311 Transportation Agreement**

Dear Ms. Bose:

On March 27, 2009, Enogex LLC (“Enogex”), an intrastate pipeline, filed, in Docket No. PR09-22-000, a “Petition of Enogex LLC for Section 311 Rate Approval under Section 284.123(b)(2) of the Commission’s Regulations.” Enogex proposed a maximum rate for a new Section 311¹ firm transportation service to be performed on the intrastate transmission facilities located in the East Zone of the Enogex Transmission System and revised zonal maximum rates for continuing Section 311 interruptible transportation service to be performed in Enogex’s East and West Zones.

Enogex submitted, as part of the filing, three Firm Section 311 Transportation Service Agreements. Enogex sought privileged treatment for the three agreements pursuant to Section 388.112(b) of the Commission’s regulations.² Enogex stated that it believes that the public disclosure of these agreements would reveal sensitive, confidential and competitive information. Each of the agreements contains a confidentiality provision requiring Enogex to maintain confidentiality of the contract. Enogex stated that it will honor such provisions to the maximum extent possible and requested confidential treatment of the agreements and sought the necessary protective measures to maintain such confidentiality.

Enogex further advised the Commission that it planned to execute a fourth Firm Section 311 Transportation Agreement in the near future and would supplement its March 27, 2009 filing with such agreement upon its execution. Enogex and the fourth shipper recently executed the agreement in question to be effective May 1, 2009.




